Luke 2:7; 2:11 KJV

<sup>7</sup>And she brought forth her firstborn son, and wrapped him in swaddling clothes, and laid him in a manger; because there was no room for them in the inn.

<sup>11</sup>For unto you is born this day in the city of David a Saviour, which is Christ the Lord.

Matthew 2:1-2; 11 KJV

<sup>1</sup>Now when Jesus was born in Bethlehem of Judaea in the days of Herod the king, behold, there came wise men from the east to Jerusalem, <sup>2</sup>Saying, Where is he that is born King of the Jews? for we have seen his star in the east, and are come to worship him.

<sup>11</sup>And when they were come into the house, they saw the young child with Mary his mother, and fell down, and worshipped him: and when they had opened their treasures, they presented unto him gifts; gold, and frankincense and myrrh.

Luke 4:16; 21 KJV

<sup>16</sup>And he came to Nazareth, where he had been brought up: and, as his custom was, he went into the synagogue on the sabbath day, and stood up for to read.

<sup>21</sup>And he began to say unto them, This day is this scripture fulfilled in your ears.

Matthew 18:2-4 KJV

<sup>2</sup>And Jesus called a little child unto him, and set him in the midst of them, <sup>3</sup>And said, Verily I say unto you, Except ye be converted, and become as little children, ye shall not enter into the kingdom of heaven. <sup>4</sup>Whosoever therefore shall humble himself as this little child, the same is greatest in the kingdom of heaven.

<sup>13</sup>Then were there brought unto him little children, that he should put his hands on them, and pray: and the disciples rebuked them. <sup>14</sup>But Jesus said, Suffer little children, and forbid them not, to come unto me: for of such is the kingdom of heaven.

Matthew 17:1-8 NASB

<sup>1</sup> Six days later Jesus took with Him Peter and James and John his brother, and led them up on a high mountain by themselves. <sup>2</sup> And He was transfigured before them; and His face shone like the sun, and His garments became as white as light. <sup>3</sup> And behold, Moses and Elijah appeared to them, talking with Him. <sup>4</sup> Peter said to Jesus, "Lord, it is good for us to be here; if You wish, I will make three tabernacles here, one for You, and one for Moses, and one for Elijah." <sup>5</sup> While he was still speaking, a bright cloud overshadowed them, and behold, a voice out of the cloud said, "This is My beloved Son, with whom I am well-pleased; listen to Him!" <sup>6</sup> When the disciples heard *this*, they fell face down to the ground and were terrified. <sup>7</sup> And Jesus came to *them* and touched them and said, "Get up, and do not be afraid." <sup>8</sup> And lifting up their eyes, they saw no one except Jesus Himself alone.

John 12:12-13 KJV

<sup>12</sup>On the next day much people that were come to the feast, when they heard that Jesus was coming to Jerusalem, <sup>13</sup>Took branches of palm trees, and went forth to meet him, and cried, Hosanna: Blessed is the King of Israel that cometh in the name of the Lord.

Luke 22:40-45 KJV

<sup>40</sup>And when he was at the place, he said unto them, Pray that ye enter not into temptation. <sup>41</sup>And he was withdrawn from them about a stone's cast, and kneeled down, and prayed, <sup>42</sup>Saying, Father, if thou be willing, remove this cup from me: nevertheless not my will, but thine, be done. <sup>43</sup>And there appeared an angel unto him from heaven, strengthening him. <sup>44</sup>And being in an agony he prayed more earnestly: and his sweat was as it were great drops of blood falling down to the ground. <sup>45</sup>And when he rose up from prayer, and was come to his disciples, he found them sleeping for sorrow,

Matthew 27:1-2 KJV

<sup>1</sup>When the morning was come, all the chief priests and elders of the people took counsel against Jesus to put him to death: <sup>2</sup>And when they had bound him, they led him away, and delivered him to Pontius Pilate the governor.

John 19:1 KJV

Then Pilate therefore took Jesus, and scourged *him*.

Matt 27:27-30

<sup>27</sup>Then the soldiers of the governor took Jesus into the common hall, and gathered unto him the whole band of soldiers. <sup>28</sup>And they stripped him, and put on him a scarlet robe. <sup>29</sup>And when they had platted a crown of thorns,

they put it upon his head, and a reed in his right hand: and they bowed the knee before him, and mocked him, saying, Hail, King of the Jews! <sup>30</sup>And they spit upon him, and took the reed, and smote him on the head.

John 19:13-15 KJV

<sup>13</sup>When Pilate therefore heard that saying, he brought Jesus forth, and sat down in the judgment seat in a place that is called the Pavement, but in the Hebrew, Gabbatha. <sup>14</sup>And it was the preparation of the passover, and about the sixth hour: and he saith unto the Jews, Behold your King! <sup>15</sup>But they cried out, Away with him, away with him, crucify him. Pilate saith unto them, Shall I crucify your King? The chief priests answered, We have no king but Caesar.

Matt 27:24-25

<sup>24</sup>When Pilate saw that he could prevail nothing, but that rather a tumult was made, he took water, and washed his hands before the multitude, saying, I am innocent of the blood of this just person: see ye to it. <sup>25</sup>Then answered all the people, and said, His blood be on us, and on our children.

Luke 23:24-25 NASB

<sup>24</sup> And Pilate pronounced sentence that their demand be granted. <sup>25</sup> And he released the man they were asking for who had been thrown into prison for insurrection and murder, but he delivered Jesus to their will.

John 19:16 KJV

<sup>16</sup>Then delivered he him therefore unto them to be crucified. And they took Jesus, and led him away.

Matt 27:21-32

<sup>31</sup>And after that they had mocked him, they took the robe off from him, and put his own raiment on him, and led him away to crucify him. <sup>32</sup>And as they came out, they found a man of Cyrene, Simon by name: him they compelled to bear his cross.

Luke 23:46 KJV

And when Jesus had cried with a loud voice, he said, Father, into thy hands I commend my spirit: and having said thus, he gave up the ghost.
