# "True or False?" John 6:60-65

I. False disciples stumble over God's Word; True disciples receive and continue in God's Word (vs. 66-61).

(Matthew 9:14; John 2:23-25; 8:31-32; Acts 19:1-3; Romans 9:30-33; 1 Peter 2:7-8; 1 John 2:3-5)

II. False disciples are spiritually dead; True disciples have been regenerated (vs. 62-63).

(1 Samuel 2:3; 16:7; 1 Kings 8:38-39; 1 Chronicles 28:9; Job 26:6; Psalm 33:13-15; Luke 16:15; John 1:12-13; 6:26; Romans 2:16; 1 Corinthians 4:5; Galatians 2:20; Titus 3:4-6; Hebrews 4:1-2; 13)

II. False disciples do not know God; True disciples know God (vs. 64-65).

(Luke 8:11-15; John 10:3-4, 16, 26-30)

## **Scripture References and Notes**

### Matthew 9:14

Then the disciples of John came to Him, asking, "Why do we and the Pharisees fast, but Your disciples do not fast?"

#### Acts 19:1-3

It happened that while Apollos was at Corinth, Paul passed through the upper country and came to Ephesus, and found some disciples. <sup>2</sup>He said to them, "Did you receive the Holy Spirit when you believed?" And they *said* to him, "No, we have not even heard whether there is a Holy Spirit." <sup>3</sup> And he said, "Into what then were you baptized?" And they said, "Into John's baptism."

# John 2:23-25

<sup>23</sup> Now when He was in Jerusalem at the Passover, during the feast, many believed in His name, observing His signs which

He was doing.<sup>24</sup> But Jesus, on His part, was not entrusting Himself to them, for He knew all men, <sup>25</sup> and because He did not need anyone to testify concerning man, for He Himself knew what was in man.

# 1 Peter 2:7-8

<sup>7</sup> This precious value, then, is for you who believe; but for those who disbelieve,

"THE STONE WHICH THE BUILDERS REJECTED, THIS BECAME THE VERY CORNER *stone*," <sup>8</sup> and, "A STONE OF STUMBLING AND A ROCK OF OFFENSE"; for they stumble because they are disobedient to the word, and to this *doom* they were also appointed.

### Romans 9:30-33

<sup>30</sup> What shall we say then? That Gentiles, who did not pursue righteousness, attained righteousness, even the righteousness which is by faith; <sup>31</sup> but Israel, pursuing a law of righteousness, did not arrive at *that* law. <sup>32</sup> Why? Because *they did* not *pursue it* by faith, but as though *it were* by works. They stumbled over the stumbling stone, <sup>33</sup> just as it is written, "BEHOLD, I LAY IN ZION A STONE OF STUMBLING AND A ROCK OF OFFENSE,

AND HE WHO BELIEVES IN HIM WILL NOT BE DISAPPOINTED."

#### John 8:31-32

<sup>31</sup> So Jesus was saying to those Jews who had believed Him, "If you continue in My word, *then* you are truly disciples of Mine; <sup>32</sup> and you will know the truth, and the truth will make you free."

## 1 John 2:3-5

<sup>3</sup> By this we know that we have come to know Him, if we keep His commandments. <sup>4</sup> The one who says, "I have come to know Him," and does not keep His commandments, is a liar, and the truth is not in him; <sup>5</sup> but whoever keeps His word, in him the love of God has truly been perfected. By this we know that we are in Him:

### Hebrews 4:1-2

Therefore, let us fear if, while a promise remains of entering His rest, any one of you may seem to have come short of it. <sup>2</sup> For indeed we have had good news preached to us, just as they also; but the word they heard did not profit them, because it was not united by faith in those who heard.

#### Titus 3:4-6

<sup>4</sup> But when the kindness of God our Savior and *His* love for mankind appeared, <sup>5</sup> He saved us, not on the basis of deeds which we have done in righteousness, but according to His mercy, by the washing of regeneration and renewing by the Holy Spirit, <sup>6</sup> whom He poured out upon us richly through Jesus Christ our Savior,

### John 1:12-13

<sup>12</sup> But as many as received Him, to them He gave the right to become children of God, *even* to those who believe in His name.

<sup>13</sup> who were born, not of blood nor of the will of the flesh nor of the will of man, but of God.

## Galatians 2:20

I have been crucified with Christ; and it is no longer I who live, but Christ lives in me; and the *life* which I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave Himself up for me.

#### John 6:26

Jesus answered them and said, "Truly, truly, I say to you, you seek Me, not because you saw signs, but because you ate of the loaves and were filled.

# 1 Samuel 2:3

"Boast no more so very proudly, Do not let arrogance come out of your mouth; For the LORD is a God of knowledge, And with Him actions are weighed.

### 1 Samuel 16:7

But the LORD said to Samuel, "Do not look at his appearance or at the height of his stature, because I have rejected him; for God *sees* not as man sees, for man looks at the outward appearance, but the LORD looks at the heart."

## 1 Kings 8:38-39

<sup>38</sup> whatever prayer or supplication is made by any man *or* by all Your people Israel, each knowing the affliction of his own heart, and spreading his hands toward this house; <sup>39</sup> then hear in heaven Your dwelling place, and forgive and act and render to each according to all his ways, whose heart You know, for You alone know the hearts of all the sons of men...

## 1 Chronicles 28:9

"As for you, my son Solomon, know the God of your father, and serve Him with a whole heart and a willing mind; for the LORD searches all hearts, and understands every intent of the thoughts. If you seek Him, He will let you find Him; but if you forsake Him, He will reject you forever.

## Job 26:6

"Naked is Sheol before Him, And Abaddon has no covering.

## Psalm 33:13-15

<sup>13</sup> The LORD looks from heaven; He sees all the sons of men; <sup>14</sup> From His dwelling place He looks out On all the inhabitants of the earth, <sup>15</sup> He who fashions the hearts of them all, He who understands all their works.

# Luke 16:15

And He said to them, "You are those who justify yourselves in the sight of men, but God knows your hearts; for that which is highly esteemed among men is detestable in the sight of God.
